

Summary

Topic of the final qualifying work: “FORMS OF LEISURE ORGANIZATION OF SENIOR SCHOOLCHILDREN USING MODERN TECHNOLOGIES (ON THE EXAMPLE OF MSEI “SECONDARY SCHOOL OF A.INZHICHISHHO NAMED AFTER DEREVA S.E.”)

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The relevance of the research. At the present stage of development of society, the leisure activities of high school students are a significant aspect of the study and research of sociology. The organization of leisure in the conditions of school and family is acquiring more and more relevant and necessary methodological and practical guidelines, as it sets prospects for the future in introducing each senior pupil to the sphere of spiritual life, spiritual and moral values, familiarizing himself with culture and art, taking into account the age characteristics of the individual. The rapid development of problems associated with the asocial behavior of high school students outside of school, which is due to a different attitude to free time, determines the need for special attention and attention to the system of organization and formation of leisure for cultural socialization. The organization of leisure for rural high school students deserves special attention, since in rural areas the possibilities to apply one or another form of organization of leisure are more limited than in cities.

The task of organizing leisure for high school students is currently being solved by many institutions. But in most cases, the solution to this problem is based on traditional, long-established and used for decades forms, such as elective classes, sections and circles devoted to all known hobbies. Meanwhile, often a significant part of fifteen-to-sixteen-year-old students, having reached this age,

are no longer interested in the traditional activities that adults usually recommend and organize the educational system. Teenagers are actively seeking communication with peers, creating their own groups and communities that are not controlled by adults. So there is a gap between young people of high school age and adults - parents, teachers, the public. Youth communities are often completely closed from adults, and young people of high school age do not see that parents and teachers are ready to understand their interests and “equal” discussion of these topics.

In connection with the foregoing, the choice of a topic related to the use of new modern technologies in the organization of leisure for high school students is quite logical.

The degree of scientific elaboration of the problem. The problems of youth leisure are addressed in the works of many foreign and domestic scientists. However, there is no comprehensive research devoted to modern forms of organization of leisure activities for senior schoolchildren using modern technologies.

The aim of the study- to investigate the forms of organization of leisure for senior schoolchildren and propose measures for their improvement on the basis of the use of modern technologies for the organization of leisure on the example of MCOU "Secondary School A.A. Inzhichishho named after S.E."

Research objectives:

- to characterize such an age and social group as older students in a sociological aspect;
- to explore the disclosure of the problem of studying the leisure of senior schoolchildren and the forms of its organization in the works of domestic and foreign scientists;
- reveal the theoretical foundations of the use of modern technology in the organization of leisure activities of high school students;
- characterize modern technologies that have successfully proven themselves in the educational practice of organizing leisure activities;
- to conduct a study of leisure preferences of high school students of MCOU "Secondary School of A. Inzhichishho named after S.E. Tree";
- propose measures to improve the organization of leisure for high school students based on the use of modern technologies.

The object of study: youth of high school age.

The subject of the study: is the content of leisure preferences among older students (aged 15-17 years) and their implementation through leisure technologies.

The theoretical and methodological basis of the study was made up of scientific works on sociology, psychology, pedagogy, devoted to the problems of leisure and its organization for young people, including for senior schoolchildren. Among them: the dissertation "Innovative trends in the field of youth leisure in modern Russia" N.V. Kotelnikova, Features of leisure time for students of a regional university ”A.V. Babello, monograph “Value orientations of schoolchildren of older adolescents” by sociologist L. Osipova and others.

In the course of the study, the following scientific methods were used: theoretical (analysis of sociological, psychological and pedagogical literature on the research problem; systematization and generalization of information); empirical (analysis of documents, questionnaires).

The empirical basis of the study: the material collected by the author during the practice at MCOU "Secondary School a. Inzhichishho named after S.E. Tree ”, materials of sociological studies of other authors about leisure preferences of young people of high school age.

Theoretical and practical significance of the research. The theoretical significance lies in the generalization of theoretical material devoted to the study of the problems of leisure for high school students and effective forms of its organization. The practical significance of the study lies in the fact that its results can be used in teaching the disciplines of the sociological cycle, as well as to improve the leisure opportunities of high school students in secondary schools, including in rural areas.

The results of the study. Based on the results of the study, it is advisable to suggest the following ways to improve the organization of leisure of high school students:

- inclusion in the leisure activities of high school students of their parents and family members, so that in the course of joint cognitive and entertaining activities the whole family would be interested in developing the abilities, skills and knowledge of the high school student and assist in their implementation.

- the use of opportunities and resources of the immediate environment of high school students (family, neighbors, yard friends), which include video and photo equipment, library collections, sports equipment, musical equipment and instruments, etc.

- the main initiative for organizing leisure for high school students should be shown to the social institutions of the village of Inzhichishkho - the school, the House of Culture, the library, as well as the administration of the village of Inzhichishkho, the administration of the Khabez municipal district, which includes the village, the education department of the Khabez municipal district, etc.

- the development of new forms of leisure on the basis of attracting the attention of high school students of modern technology, including using modern equipment and communications, IT, telecommunications, Internet resources and tools.

- the organization in the community of the aul of joint socially useful and educational activities of adults and youth, including high school students.

As a promising form of organizing leisure for high school students using modern technologies, it is proposed to conduct photocrosses. An example of the organization of leisure activities for students of high school age using modern technologies is developed - Photocross "The world is reflected in Inzhichishkho."
