

SUMMARY

Research topic: Correlation of the linguistic economy indicators in texts of different functional styles

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Topicality of the research is in the increasing focus of linguists and linguistics in common on the linguistic economy studies and in the lack of commonly acknowledged opinion in respect of reasons and prerequisites which cause the linguistic economy principle in the language and the speech. Deficient research of some of the processes and phenomenon of the informal speech which lead to minimization of speech efforts is another one topical factor. To emphasize particularly is that there weren't any studies on linguistic economy in point of functional styles before.

Objective of the present work is to investigate the linguistic economy phenomenon as one of the devices of language progress and rationalization and detection of its indicators and their correlation in different functional styles.

Research objectives are as follows:

1. generalization of theoretical studies on the linguistic economy phenomenon;
2. review of the common propositions regarding linguistic economy and its language resources;
3. reasoning of the relevance of linguistic economy studying as one of the fundamental factors of language changes and development;

4. review of the theoretical grounds of functional styles' differentiation and generalization of their main features;

5. description of the main linguistic economy means, detection of their indicators and their correlation in different functional styles.

Theoretical significance of the qualification paper consists in the fact, that its findings summarize previous research data on the problem of linguistic economy and detect its principal means and indicators in the speech and the language.

Practical significance of the research is in the possibility of its further usage in teaching and translating as well as the following deeper investigation of linguistic economy and text-making of all functional styles.

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
