Topical importance: The relevance of the research topic is due to several factors. Being a significant phenomenon in the organization and functioning of the world community migration remains a global problem of the modern world. In this context, the need to study migrants as representatives of the migration process arose, reflecting all aspects of this process, with the aim of forming a concept that represents a fragment of the world or part of such a fragment in language signs. The study of the conceptual structure allows to reveal the deeper and more significant properties of the object or phenomenon. Consideration of the concept through its structure, known to all members of the language community, suggests that the concept has a national and cultural specificity.

Goals: to conduct a comparative analysis of the linguistic features of the implementation of the concept of "migrants" in English, German and Russian languages.

Tasks:

1. to describe language means objectifying the concept "migrants" in German, Russian and English languages;
2. to examine the etymology of the words representing the concept;
4. to analyze the lexical meanings of the words representing the concept;

The results of the study:
