Title: The category of locality in military discourse.

Topical Importance: The space is one of the basic philosophical categories and a fundamental element of perception of the world. The category of locality as a concept can be expressed in different forms and by different linguistic means. The system of spatial values in any discourse does not always coincide with such system in other discourses. The identification of these differences in order to achieve understanding of meaning is quite important.

Goals: to research the ways of verbalization of category of locality in military discourse in Spanish and Russian languages.

Tasks:

1. To define the concept of military discourse.
2. To delineate the limits of formal and informal military discourse.
3. To define the concept of "locality".
4. To identify the regularities of representation of category of locality.
5. To describe the common ways of verbalization of category of locality in various types of military discourse.
6. To identify the distinctive peculiarities of the locality in various types of military discourse.

Theoretical value and practical applicability: the research contributes to the development of the theory of discourse, and to the further study of the category of locality in Spanish and Russian languages.
