«PROVERBS AND ANTI-PROVERBS WITH GENDER COMPONENT IN
THE MODERN ENGLISH LANGUAGE»

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The relevance of the research topic is determined by the fact that proverbs containing a gender component reflect the ideas formed in the national tradition about the place of men and women in society, about the requirements imposed on representatives of different sexes, about the differences in the character and behavior of men and women. These ideas, which have developed over the centuries, largely determine modern gender relations, the evolution of which is reflected by anti-proverbs containing a gender component, which allows us to trace the representation of images of men and women in the language.

The object of the study in the final qualification work is English proverbs and anti-proverbs with a gender component.

The subject of the study is the study of the gender characteristics of these proverbs, as well as the image of a man and a woman, fixed in modern proverbs and anti-proverbs of the English language.

The purpose of the study is to study proverbs and anti-proverbs with a gender component in the modern English language.

The aim of the study is to fulfill a number of interrelated **research tasks** aimed at:

- 1) to reveal the formation of the concept of "gender" in linguistics;
- 2) to study domestic and foreign gender studies in linguistics;
- 3) define gender in the phraseology of the English language;
- 4) describe proverbs with a gender component denoting men;
- 5) analyze proverbs with a gender component denoting women;
- 6) consider anti-proverbs with a gender component denoting men;
- 7) study anti-proverbs with a gender component denoting women.

The theoretical significance of the study lies in the possibility of a deeper and more systematic analysis of scientific ideas about language as a means of constructing gender. In addition, the generalization and systematization of knowledge about the phraseological system of the language as a means of reflecting gender stereotypes is carried out. The study of proverbs and anti-proverbs with a gender component influences the study of the phraseological system of the language in the

context of culture. The results of this study can be used to further study gender stereotypes and cultural attitudes recorded in different languages.

The practical value of the study is that the obtained data can be applied in theoretical courses in general linguistics, lexicology, phraseology, intercultural communication, and special courses on gender issues.

Research result.

1. The main aspects of the formation of gender linguistics were analyzed, the concept of "gender" in the framework of the development of the science of language was considered.

2. The role of phraseological units in the construction of gender is studied.

3. Proverbs with a gender component that represent and characterize men and women were selected.

4. The proverbs with the "man" component are analyzed and the proverbs that relate not to men, in particular, but to humanity as a whole are identified.

5. The characteristics of men and women fixed in proverbs and anti-proverbs are revealed; the lexical units that are components of these proverbs are investigated.

6. A comparative analysis of the ideas about male and female persons in proverbs and anti-proverbs is carried out.

Recommendations for the implementation of the practical research results: the practical results of the research are presented in the form of an educational product "English proverbs and anti-proverbs with gender component" can be used in theoretical courses in phraseology, special courses on gender issues, as well as in further research in the field of gender linguistics.
