

The theme of the graduate qualification work: "Features of the formation and functioning of modern English legal terminology."

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The relevance of the research topic is due to the fact that jurisprudence is one of the most important scientific knowledge, as well as the terminology is one of the most complex and diverse systems of the English language. Any terminological system is a branch of a common language that is studied by students of linguistic specialties or people studying English quite superficially. And for students of legal specialties, the problem is the English language itself, the training of which is compulsory for those wishing to specialize in English law. Vocabulary correspondences of English and Russian terms do not always completely coincide in meaning, that is, they require a detailed study and explanation.

The purpose of the work - the study and classification of formation and the functioning of modern English legal terminology.

The objectives of the research:

1. to highlight the types of lexical means of expression in English-language legal terminology;
2. to determine the frequency of use of lexical means to expression in English-language legal terminology;
3. to conduct a parts-of-speech-classification of terminological units;
4. to describe and classify examples of homonymy, synonymy and proprietary nomenclature;
5. to explore the features of the translation of special legal terms;
6. to develop a glossary of key legal terms.

The theoretical and practical relevance of the research. Information in scientific special texts is encoded in terms or in traditional single knowledge. As we can see, the use of legal terms raises many terminological problems. Thus, the theoretical significance of this study is to determine the role of term formation as a way of nominating legal phenomena.

The practical value of the study is due to the fact that its results can be used in the curriculum of the English language course for students of law faculties, universities and colleges, as well as in the program of students of linguistic universities to expand the vocabulary of specific languages.
