

Summary

Subject Matter: Lexico-semantic field "good/evil" in modern German

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Topicality of the research: the research of the vocabulary system problems on the material of the separate semantic field.

The task of the research:

- 1) to study scientific literature on the topic of the research;
- 2) to consider the history of the theory of the lexical field in linguistics origin;
- 3) to consider the types of the linguistic fields and define the concepts "lexico-semantic field" and "lexico-semantic group";
- 4) to consider the concepts "good and evil in the philosophical-ethic aspect";
- 5) to consider the concepts "good/evil as an object of linguistic research";
- 6) to take away lexical units with the value "good" and "evil" and to analyze their semantic structure;
- 7) to describe the semantic, structural and functional parameters of lexical units entering in the complement of the semantic field "good/evil".

The theoretical significance of the research consists in complex studying of units making the semantic field "kindly/angrily", opening new prospects both for the detection of its lexico-semantic features, and for the definition of the lexical means of the analyzed semantics role in a language picture of the world.

The practical significance of the research consists in possibility of the results of research use in the courses of lexicology and stylistics of modern German, by reading special courses on lexical semantics, and also when writing course and theses.

The results of the research: the example of the research of the semantic field "good/an evil" in modern German proves the possibility of its description, as in any other field structure. The scientific reflection of this fragment of the objective reality in Russian and German languages from the point of view of comparable analysis of language means can also be very perspective.
