

ABSTRACT

Final qualifying work on the topic: "Methods of migration conflicts preventing in the European Union (on the example of Germany and France)"

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Structure of the work is determined by the purpose, objectives and internal logic of the problem and consists of an introduction, two chapters consisting of 4 paragraphs, conclusion and bibliography. The bibliography contains 107 sources, including 16 in foreign languages. The total amount of the work is 77 pages of printed text.

Relevance of the research issue. An increasing number of states are involved in migration processes in the current context of globalization, while negative consequences of this phenomenon on international level are being keenly felt. At the same time, chances to fix the problem of forced migration (particularly, to EU) by efforts of particular states are near-zero until third world countries are taken to more developed economic stage and removed from armed conflicts. Due to these reasons, we can consider the problem of migration one of the most urgent and difficult to regulate in modern realities.

Research objective is to develop recommendations for prevention of migration conflicts in EU.

Research problems: 1) to explore the nature and determinants of migration conflicts; 2) to explore the theoretical basis for prevention of migration conflicts; 3) to analyze migration conflicts in Germany and work out a list of recommendations for their prevention; 4) to analyze migration conflicts in France and work out a list of recommendations for their prevention.

Recommendations:

1. Stopping the "open door" policy and providing asylum to refugees, but not economic migrants.
2. Encouraging refugees to seek employment and sustainment.
3. The difficulty of reunion migrants with relatives and diasporas.
4. Providing of social benefits through investing by specialized organizations, developed Arab countries and diasporas existing in the country.
5. Redirecting of finances' part providing social benefits to migrants to development and realization of measures for integration and inform of migrants on the problems of terrorism and extremism in the country.
6. Paying more attention to the rights of German people not only migrants and development of patriotism.
7. Directing of part of the budget to strengthen law enforcement agencies, as well as to ensure activity of qualified conflict managers.
8. Extension of institutionalization of intercultural and interreligious dialogue policy.
9. Development and funding of counter-terrorism programs.
10. Development of an organized system of illegal migrants' deportation.
11. Increase of camps and accommodation places (in particular, primary) for refugees.
12. Fight against stereotyping.
