The relevance of the study. The problems of urban space become a real challenge to philosophy, because philosophical reasoning was most often characterized by the study of non-historical and non-anthropogenic characteristics of space, while the modern city is not just a social entity, but a special type of existence where the social finds its embodiment in the material, more precisely where the material and the social cannot be separated and differentiated.

The objectives of the study included:

- consider the basic approaches to the definition of space in philosophy;
- to analyze the motor theories of space from the perspective of philosophical and managerial aspects;
- consider the problem of the spatial existence of the city;
- conduct a philosophical conceptualization of the concept of "atmosphere of the city";
- consider the philosophical aspects of the perception of the transitive spaces of the city;
