

SUMMARY

The subject matter: Typology of nominal categories in German, English and Russian languages.

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Topicality of the research: the nominal categories in German, English and Russian languages are described in comparison with each other in the context of a single work.

The goal of research: to make a comprehensive analysis of the typological categories in German, English and Russian languages.

The objectives of research: 1) to describe the typology as a branch of linguistics; 2) to highlight the typological relationship of languages as a problem of general typology;
