Relevance of the research: The relevance of the topic of this work is due to the fact that political discourse has recently become an object of research in many scientific fields. Political communication attracts the attention of political scientists, psychologists, philosophers, sociologists, linguists. The interest in these studies is due to the needs of linguistics and stylistics, as well as the lack of standardized methods for analyzing political texts according to certain criteria.

Goals: The purpose of the research is to analyze the features of the functioning of morbial metaphors in political discourse in Spanish.

Tasks:

1. to give a concept and characterize the essence of discourse;
2. consider a conceptual metaphor in the linguistic picture of the world;
3. to study the processes of metaphorization in political discourse;
4. to determine the place of morbial metaphor in modern linguistic research.

5. to determine the models of morbid metaphor in political discourse by the example of speeches of politicians of different years, as well as materials of the periodical press of Spain related to the topic of politics, available in electronic form.

Theoretical and practical significance of the research: The theoretical significance of the study lies in the fact that it expands scientific ideas about the specifics of the functioning of morbid metaphors in political discourse in Spanish. The practical significance of the research on the topic of this work lies in the fact that the results of the research can be used to prepare lecture material on such disciplines as "Theory and practice of translation", "Stylistics of the Spanish language".

Research results: In general, the conducted research has proved the relevance of this topic, so work in this direction can be continued. The first chapter is devoted to the general characteristics of metaphor in political discourse, and is the result of work on literary sources reflecting domestic and foreign experience that meets the goals and objectives of the admission qualification work. The second chapter is devoted to the analysis of the functioning of the morbid metaphor in Spanish political discourse.

Recommendations: In particular, morbid metaphors can be further investigated within the framework of another type of discourse or in texts of another genre (for example, on the material of fiction) in order to identify common and particular features of their representation and possible features.
